



**PROTOCOL FOR THE RECEIVING OF REGULAR REPORTS
ON DISCLOSURES AND DECISIONS
UNDER SECTION 49 OF THE POLICE SERVICES ACT
(SECONDARY ACTIVITIES)**

**BETWEEN
THE TAY VALLEY POLICE SERVICES BOARD
AND
THE ONTARIO PROVINCIAL POLICE DETACHMENT COMMANDER**

[Police Services Act, Section 10(9)(e)]

WHEREAS, Tay Valley Township is required pursuant to Section 10(2) of the *Police Services Act* to have a Police Services Board;

AND WHEREAS, the Detachment Commander is required to provide to the Police Services Board regular reports on disclosures and decisions made under Section 49 of the *Police Services Act*.

AND WHEREAS, the Tay Valley Police Services Board acknowledges that disclosures and decisions made under Section 49 of the *Police Services Act* are the responsibility of the Director, Professional Standards Branch;

THEREFORE THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE THAT:

1. The Ontario Provincial Police Detachment Commander, or designate, shall provide the Tay Valley Police Services Board with reports quarterly on disclosures and decisions under Section 49 of the *Police Services Act*.
2. The report shall be restricted to disclosures and decisions for those officers under the command of the Detachment Commander who are assigned full-time or regular policing responsibilities within the municipality.
