

PROTOCOL FOR THE USE AND DEPLOYMENT OF THE ELECTRONIC POLE MOUNTED SPEED SIGN

BETWEEN THE TAY VALLEY POLICE SERVICES BOARD AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF TAY VALLEY TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, Tay Valley Township is required pursuant to Section 4(1) of the *Police Services Act* to provide adequate and effective police services in accordance with its needs;

AND WHEREAS, Tay Valley Township has entered into a contract with the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services pursuant to Section 10(1) of the *Police Services Act* for the provision of police services for the municipality by the Ontario Provincial Police;

AND WHEREAS, the Township is required pursuant to Section 10(2) of the *Police Services Act* to have a Police Services Board;

AND WHEREAS, the Township purchased an Electronic Pole Mounted Speed Sign (the "Electronic Speed Sign") for use by both the Public Works Department and the Police Services Board;

THEREFORE THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE THAT:

- 1. The Township shall maintain ownership and possession of the Electronic Speed Sign and responsibility for its care, custody and control and shall maintain, repair and insure the Electronic Speed Sign at its expense.
- 2. The Township and the Police Services Board agree that the Township will use and deploy the Electronic Speed Sign to monitor and promote the awareness of speed limit designations on highways within the boundaries of the Township and to promote community events sponsored by the Township and the Police Services Board.
- 3. The Township shall use and deploy the Electronic Speed Sign in accordance with an annual Electronic Speed Sign Deployment Schedule to be mutually established and agreed upon no later than March 31 of each year. Amendments to the Electronic Speed Sign Deployment Schedule shall be mutually agreed to.
- 4. The Police Services Board recognizes that the Electronic Speed Sign Deployment Schedule must take into account the deployment requirements of the Public Works Department.

5. The Township shall download and provide the Police Services Board with the data collected from the Electronic Speed Sign by the 15th day of each month for the previous month.
