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## Tay Valley Township Approves 2020 Budget – Includes Funding for Infrastructure Renewal as well as Perth and Smiths Falls District Hospital Core Capital Campaign

At its meeting on December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019, Tay Valley Township Council gave final approval to its 2020 budget. The 2020 budget will see a 4.19% tax levy increase. This is comprised of:

- 1.25% (\$69,837) for operational increases
- 1.72% (\$96,235) for additional allocations to reserves for future needs and capital replacements, and
- 1.22% (\$67,944) to the Perth & Smiths Falls District Hospital for capital needs.
- 4.19% (\$234,016) TOTAL

The Township's Strategic Plan, Vision for the Future includes the following: "Financial Sustainability" - strives to have stable tax rates and debt ratios and be able to fund our desired programs and infrastructure. With this in mind, Council is allocating an additional \$96,235 into reserves for future capital replacements to ensure that Tay Valley is sustainable into the future. The budget also includes \$67,944 as Tay Valley's contribution to the P&SFD Hospital request to fund their core capital campaign.

The total 2020 tax requirement of \$5,825,774 is \$234,016 or 4.19% more than was required in 2019. This represents an approximate increase of \$23 on a residential property assessed at \$300,000.

Highlights of Tay Valley's approximate \$3.1 million-dollar infrastructure renewal and replacement program includes the following for 2020:

- Roads & Bridges projects \$2,240,000
- Vehicles & Equipment replacement projects \$645,000
- Building & Property projects \$124,019
- Studies & IT maintenance projects \$85,400
