**1.1 THAT,** the 2016 Budget, including revenue and expenditure estimates for the year, attached hereto as Schedule "A", is hereby adopted.

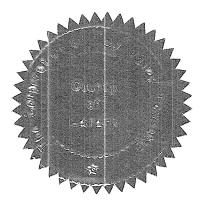
#### 2. ULTRA VIRES
