BETWEEN:

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH SHERBROOKE,

hereinafter called the "TOWNSHIP",

of the FIRST PART,

-and

LAKESIDE LIVING LIMITED, a Company incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontaric, having its Head Office at the City of Ottawa in the Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton, hereinafter called "LAKESIDE",

of the SECOND PART.

WHEREAS Lakeside has constructed a road on the lands described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

AND WHEREAS the Township has agreed to accept the said road as a public highway subject to the terms hereinafter set forth.

NCW THEREFORE, this Agreement witnesseth that in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions herein contained, and the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), the parties hereto agree as follows:-

- 1. The Township assumes the lands described in Schedule "A" attached hereto as a public highway subject to the terms hereinafter set forth.
- 2. The responsibility for maintenance of the said road shall remain with Lakeside and all other present users of the road and any future users of the said road, and Lakeside acknowledges on behalf of itself, its successors and assigns, the user or users from time to time of the said road described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, that the Township will not accept responsibility for the maintenance and care of the said road until assumption of the said road is deemed advisable by the Council of the Township, and not until it is brought up to standards acceptable to The Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

In the event that Lakeside or future users of the road wish the said road to be assumed and maintained by the Township, it is agreed by Lakeside that it shall be its responsibility, or in the event that all of its land has been conveyed it shall be the responsibility of all users of the road to bring the road up to standards (acceptable to The Ministry of Transportation and Communications) at its or their expense.

- 3. Lakeside agrees to make all purchasers of lands, which purchasers will become users of this road, aware of the provisions of this Agreement as it pertains to this road, and further to obtain from such purchasers at the time of purchase, such acknowledgments and/or agreements as may be deemed necessary by the Township to give full effect to the terms of this Agreement.
- 4. It is agreed by the parties hereto that the conveyance necessary to transfer the ownership of the said lands from Lakeside Living Limited to the Township shall be made by a deed registered immediately before this Agreement.
