KEY ACTIVITIES

- 1. Operates all light equipment as required to fulfill assigned duties including trucks, snow plows, etc., while excluding graders, loaders and back hoes
- 2. Maintains roads in accordance with standards through hard and loose top spring, summer and fall maintenance programs and in winter by snowplowing, salting and sanding in accordance with established routes and standards.
- 3. Identifies road-related problems as Lead Hand or the Public Works Superintendent.
- 4. Conducts daily inspection and maintains equipment in a safe operating condition by following acceptable maintenance and servicing schedules (oil changes, filters and lubrications, etc) according to service manuals performing repairs or replacement work and recommending repairs or replacement to the Public Works Superintendent.
