<b>Sorting at Site:</b> for tagged bag improperly containing recyclables or compostable waste	\$5.00
<b>Brush Waste:</b> (Stanleyville only) tree and brush clippings, small branches, hedge trimmings, Christmas trees	\$5.00/ Cubic Yard
<b>Untreated Lumber:</b> (Glen Tay & Stanleyville only) Unpainted, no pressure treated	No Charge
<b>Bulk Waste:</b> (Glen Tay only) Any commercial, Industrial or institutional waste from a Business Establishment. E.g. Drywall, Treated Lumber, Wall to Wall Carpets, Hot Tubs, Treated Lumber.	\$50.00/ Cubic Yard
<b>Construction Waste:</b> (Glen Tay only) Discarded building material, resulting from erection, repair, demolition or improvement of buildings.	\$50.00/ Cubic Yard

## DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS WASTE

### HOURS OF OPERATION

(Open Victoria Day Weekend to Thanksgiving)  
Monday: 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.  
Wednesday: 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.  
Saturday: 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

**Directions from Perth:** Take Hwy #511 to Lanark Village. Stay on Hwy #511 (approx. 10 km) to Hopetown. Turn right onto County Road 16 (Wolf Grove Road). The waste site is located on the left hand side of the road just after the bridge and entrance has a green metal fence.

To access this facility you are required to know your address and show identification. Waste items must be identifiable and in a sealed container or package. This facility cannot accept bulk flammable or highly vaporous liquids – therefore any containers holding these liquids will NOT be accepted. (E.g. gasoline containers).



**✓ Items accepted are:** Motor Oil, Antifreeze, Oil Filters Flammable Liquids (gasoline, solvents, strippers, turpentine), Latex Paint, Oil Paint & Stain, Organic Flammable (adhesives, driveway sealant, caulk, resin), Propane Cylinders, Lead Acid Vehicle Batteries or Dry Cell Batteries, Aerosol Cans, Acid or Base Corrosives (cleaners, drain openers, rust remover), Pesticide, Oxidizers (pool chemicals, fertilizer), Fire Extinguishers.

**✗ Items not accepted:** Ammunition, Explosives or Flares, Asbestos, P.C.B Contaminated Waste (fluorescent light ballasts), radioactive waste (smoke detectors). For a full listing of items NOT accepted please visit our website at [www.tayvalleytwp.ca](http://www.tayvalleytwp.ca).

**Note:** Local stores will accept the following hazardous waste:

Canadian Tire: waste oil, oil filters, anti-freeze and car batteries.

Home Hardware Building Centre: paint cans (paint has to be liquid, they will not accept cans that are rusted).

## WASTE MANAGEMENT

There is one waste site in Tay Valley Township at Glen Tay, and two transfer stations: one in Stanleyville and one in Maberly, where household waste and recyclables are collected but not land-filled on site.

In order to access the waste sites, you need a "Waste Disposal Site Card". The card is good for as long as you own property, and must be available for presentation each and every time you go to the waste site. Waste Disposal Site Cards are available from the Municipal Office.

## CLEAR BAGS

On January 1st, 2016 Tay Valley Township implemented the use of clear garbage bags for household garbage. The change was recommended by the Waste Management Working Group to follow the Strategic Plan and was adopted by Tay Valley Council to increase waste diversion. Waste diversion means **less cost** for residents as our **waste sites remain viable longer**.



## BAG TAGS

Bag tags are available at the Municipal Office and are made available each January for the year. Each household will receive 30 tags for 2016 and **20 tags for 2017**. Additional tags cost \$1.00 each.

### CARDBOARD BIN (collapsed, bundled & clean)

- Cereal, Cracker, Cake Mix & Pizza Boxes
- Brown Paper Bags
- Toilet/Paper Towel Rolls
- Cardboard Egg Cartons

### SCRAP METAL BIN

- Copper
- Steel
- Galvanized Pipe
- Aluminum
- Metal Furniture

### GLASS BIN/PIT

- Clear & Coloured Glass Dishes
- Glass Beverage Container
- Glass Food Jars

### CAN BIN

- Tin/Aluminum (e.g. pie plates, foil, Cans: soup, pet food, pop)

### CLEAN PLASTIC BIN (empty & clean)

Plastics #1-#7 from Consumer Index (e.g. pop bottle, yogurt container, laundry soap, shampoo/conditioner bottles, condiment bottles, water bottles)

### NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

- Fluorescent tubes (see hazardous waste)
- Styrofoam (household waste)
- Textiles (please take clean textiles to local depots)
- Food wrap, plastic lunch & freezer bags, milk bags, shopping bags, bread bags, sheeting (this is household waste)
- Light Bulbs (household waste)
- Plastic flower pots
- Fast food coffee cups (e.g. McDonald's, Tim Horton's)

## COMPOSTING PROGRAM

The Township encourages residents to compost household and garden waste (such as brush) at home. It is a great way to reduce your household garbage.

Including compost in regular bagged garbage is not permitted under By-law 98-68. Fines may be payable. If home composting is not feasible, Glen Tay and Stanleyville sites will accept compost. Only the following materials may be placed there.

- Food Waste (fruits, vegetables, bread)
- Serviettes, Paper Towels, Tissues (clean)
- Sawdust, Shaving, Wood Chips
- Leaves & Grass (out of the bag)
- Plants
- Dryer Lint

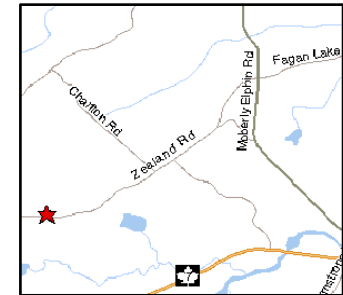
