

Waste Site Tipping Fees

ITEM	FEE
Illegal Dumping Fee: for disposing of waste at a non-designated area	Min. \$250 charge, \$125/hr after
Sorting at Site: For tagged bag improperly containing recyclables or compostable waste	\$5.00
Brush Waste: (Glen Tay only) Tree and brush clippings, small branches, hedge trimmings, Christmas trees	\$5.00/cubic yard
Bulk Waste: (Glen Tay only)	\$50.00/cubic yard
Construction Waste: (Glen Tay only) Discarded building material, resulting from erection, repair, demolition or improvement of buildings.	\$50.00/cubic yard
• Shingles	\$100/cubic yard or \$6.00/bundle
• Untreated lumber waste unpainted, no pressure treated	\$5.00/cubic yard
Major Appliances and Large Household Furnishings Waste:	
• Reusable Furniture	No Fee
• Large non-reusable furniture (e.g. sofas, mattresses, box-springs)	\$15.00
• Small non-reusable furniture (e.g. chairs, bookcases, cabinets, side tables)	\$10.00
• Stove, washer, dryer, fridge & freezer with freon removed	No Fee
• Small appliances (e.g. blender, toaster)	No Fee
• Large propane cylinder	No Fee
Refrigerant Units: (Glen Tay only) Fridges, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers with Freon	\$25.00
Scrap Metal Waste:	No Fee

NOTE: Please be prepared to show your 'Waste Disposal Site Card' - available at the Municipal Office.

What's ACCEPTED...

- Filters, Flammable Liquids (gasoline, solvents, strippers, turpentine)
- Latex Paint, Oil Paint & Stain, Organic Flammable Products (adhesives, driveway sealant, caulk, resin)
- Propane Cylinders
- Fire Extinguishers
- Aerosol Cans, Acid or Base Corrosives (cleaners, drain openers, rust remover)
- Lead Acid Vehicle Batteries or Dry Cell Batteries
- Pesticide, Oxidizers (pool chemicals, fertilizer)
- Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs/Tubes



What's NOT ACCEPTED...

- Ammunition, Explosives or Flares, Asbestos, P.C.B Contaminated Waste (fluorescent light ballasts), radioactive waste (smoke detectors).

Each household will receive 20 bag tags per year and are available at the Municipal Office
Additional tags are \$1.00 each.



✔ What's IN...

MIXED PAPER BIN

- Newspapers and Flyers (Plastic bags removed)
- Magazines, Catalogues, Junk Mail, Office and Shredded Paper (NOT in plastic bags)
- Telephone Books, Reading Books (Hard covers removed)

CARDBOARD BIN

- Cereal and other Food Boxes, Tissue and Shoe Boxes
- Paper Rolls from Paper Towel and Toilet Paper
- Corrugated Boxes (Flattened and bundled)
- Pizza boxes (Clean)

SCRAP METAL BIN

- Aluminum Pop Cans, Steel Food Cans, Aluminum Foil and Trays (Clean)

(NOT #6 Polystyrene/Styrofoam)

PLASTIC BIN

- #1 - #7 Plastic (Clean and Empty) Food and Drink containers and Plastic Egg Cartons
- Shampoo/Conditioner Bottles
- Plastic water Bottles

GLASS BIN

- Food and Beverage Jars and Bottles (Clean and Empty)

- Styrofoam (#6 polystyrene)
- Flower/plant pots and trays
- Chip bags and candy bar wrappers
- Paper coffee cup (Timmy's) and waxed cardboard
- Plastic bags (grocery bags, Zip-lock & all film plastic)
- Soiled paper and Pizza boxes with food residue
- Non-food Container Metal, Plastic or Glass (like clothes hangers, toys, dishes)
- Light bulbs
- Reports with plastic spines
- Textiles and Fabric (please take to depots - clean)
- Oil Containers and Florescent tubes (go to Hazardous waste)

NO Portable Propane Cylinders!
