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#### INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Inhabitants and Ratepayers of the Corporation of Tay Valley Township

We have audited the accompanying Form 4 of Judy Farrell at December 31, 2018.

This return has been prepared by the Candidate based on the financial reporting provisions of Section 88.25 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, the Candidate's Guide, and in the prescribed Form issued by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs.

## The Candidate's Responsibility for the Form 4

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation of Form 4 in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Section 88.25 of the Elections Act, the Candidate's Guide, and in the prescribed form issued by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs.

#### Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Form 4 based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Form is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the Form. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Form, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers fair presentation of the Form in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit also includes evaluating the overall presentation of the Form.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

## **Basis of Qualified Opinion**

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the Candidate's bank account and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions, other revenues and expenses.



## **Qualified Opinion**

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the 'Basis of Qualified Opinion' paragraph, the Form 4 of Judy Farrell for the period ending December 31, 2018 is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of section 88.25 of the Municipal Elections Act, the Candidate's Guide, and in the prescribed Form issued by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs.

## Basis of Accounting and Restriction of Use

Without modifying our opinion, the Form is prepared to assist the Candidate to meet the requirements of the Municipal Elections Act. As a result, the Form may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the Candidate and the Chief Electoral Officer, and should not be used by parties other that the Candidate and the Chief Electoral Officer.

# Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

As required by Subsection 88.25 of the Municipal Elections Act, in our opinion, the Form presents the information contained in the financial records on which it is based.
