Reporting to the Community Services Coordinator, the Sports & Recreation Coordinator will develop, coordinate, facilitate, and promote current and new sports & recreation activities and programs that are accessible, age-friendly, effective, and pandemic resilient, and that will serve the physical and emotional wellness needs of Tay Valley Township residents and visitors in ways that increase physical activity and strengthen community connections.

The Township is seeking a motivated and results-oriented individual to join our team. The ideal candidate will have attained post-secondary education related to sports and/or recreational programming or a related field of study, or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience, as well as two (2) years progressively related experience in sports and/or recreation programming, preferably with participants from across the life cycle, from children, through to youth, working adults and seniors, experience working with volunteers and in monitoring, evaluating and reporting program results.
