BY-LAWS

THE CORPORATION OF TAY VALLEY TOWNSHIP

BY-LAW NO. 2021-054

APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF

WHEREAS, Section 6(1) of the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act*, S.0. 1997, Chapter 4, as amended, provides that if a fire department is established for the whole or a part of a municipality or for more than one municipality, the Council of the municipality or the Councils of the municipalities, as the case may be, shall appoint a fire chief for the fire department;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement between the Township of Drummond/North Elmsley and Tay Valley Township establishing the Drummond/North Elmsley Tay Valley Fire Board, the hiring of a Fire Chief and Station Chiefs shall be approved by the Councils of both municipalities;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Council of the Corporation of Tay Valley Township enacts as follows:

1.	DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF		
	1.1	THAT, be appointed as Deputy Fire Chief for the Drummond/North Elmsley Tay Valley Fire Rescue.	
	1.2	THAT, the duties, responsibilities and authority of the Deputy Fire Chief shall be as set out in the Employment Agreement between and the Drummond North Elmlsey Tay Valley Fire Rescue, dated December 6 th , 2021.	
2.	ULTRA VIRES		
	Should any sections of this by-law, including any section or part of any schedules attached hereto, be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be ultra vires, the remaining sections shall nevertheless remain valid and binding.
