

What to Expect

Brand new to Eastern Ontario, the Ontario East Rails & Trails Loop takes snowmobilers through rugged Lanark County, Ottawa Valley, and Frontenac County countryside, peppered with scenic small towns to warm up in.

The loop is approximately 267 kms of beautiful wintry terrain on the Ottawa Valley Recreation Trail (OVRT), crisscrossing the Mississippi River in Carleton Place, Almonte and Pakenham, before heading north to the Ottawa Valley and then looping south through North Frontenac's hilly Canadian Shield territory.

This one, two, or three-day tour will take you through Lanark County's snowmobile friendly communities, where local businesses are ready to warm you from the inside out. Travel through a winter wonderland, picture-perfect small towns and protected wildlife corridors along trails and former railbeds.

What to See & Do

Launch your exploration of Lanark County's snow territory at any one of the small towns peppered along the route: Smiths Falls, Carleton Place, Almonte, or Pakenham. There are ample places to park at any of these locations and the shopping, food and drink, and other amenities will invite you to explore before pulling on your helmet for your ride.

Plan your route to include lengthy stops or overnight stays in one of these communities, where you'll find quality food and drink, artisan chocolate makers, coffee roasters and more. Boutique shops on heritage downtown streets are within walking distance to most snowmobile-friendly accommodations.

In Carleton Place, the brand-new Comfort Inn, offers a safe parking area, and is close to groceries, restaurants, and entertainment. In Perth, there are a number of options to park your sled at the end of the day along Highway 7, including the Aquarius Motel, Colonial Inn and Tay Inn. In Smiths Falls the Best Western is within walking distance of everything you need for a good night's rest - groceries, restaurants, fuel, and walking trails along the historic Rideau Canal.


